- Days:      Monday: **M**      Tuesday: **T**      Wednesday: **W**      Thursday: **R**      Friday: **F**
- CRN is the Course Reference Number that you will type in Banner Self-Service to register for a particular class.
- \*Section is the way the university identifies classes.
  - **A-Q**: Regular Day Class
  - **U**: Pre-semester Class (taught during semester break- pay attention to dates)
  - **V**: Night Class (anything beginning 4pm or later)
  - **W**: Web Class (Completely Online)
  - **WH**: Web Hybrid (Some work done online and some in class)
  - **X**: for online-degree students **ONLY** – most classes are accelerated in 4 or 7 week format.
  - **R**: for College Prep/Dual Enrollment students **ONLY**
  - **OA/OB**: for Online RN to BSN students **ONLY**
- Level – UG is for Undergraduate; those pursuing an Associate or Bachelor's degree.
- Term Info – Indicates if class is full semester, one of our shorter sessions or a session P (pre-semester).
